FROM THE PRESIDENT'S DESK

India is a global supplier of life-saving, affordable and good quality generic medicines, yet lakhs of families are driven into poverty because they are forced to spend much of their earnings and savings on medications to treat chronic and life threatening diseases. The poor, particularly, spend disproportionately large amount of their income as out-of-pocket expenditure on healthcare, mostly to buy medicines.

Health Crisis: Patient-doctor ratio (No. of doctors for 10,000 people). India: 1, Australia: 249, Canada: 209, UK: 166, US: 548. Estimated Shortfall in India (in lakh): Doctors (6), Dentists (2) and Nurses (10)

According to a Planning Commission report, while India is short of six lakh doctors, 10 lakh nurses and two lakh dental surgeons, Indian doctors & nurses who have migrated to developed countries form big portion of their total workforce. Almost > 60,000 Indian physicians and > 1 lakh nurses are estimated to be working in countries like US, UK, Canada and Australia alone.

India ranks at the top of nations whose physicians are working in the major developed countries. India has also emerged as one of the top suppliers of other categories of healthcare professionals, particularly radiologists, laboratory technicians, dental hygienists, physiotherapists and medical rehabilitation workers. Moreover, there is a considerable skew in the distribution of doctors with the urban to rural doctor density ratio being 5:1. We are finding it impossible to engage doctors and specialists in aspirational Districts. The only way to accomplish this is for the medical education sector to be opened up completely for private sector participation.

Despite the best efforts, it could take up to 20 years to make up the supply of doctors. Currently, most of our rural and poor population is denied quality care, leaving them in the clutches of quacks. Self-styled doctors & midwiferies without formal training provide up to 75 per cent of primary care visits. Moreover, at present, doctors without 57.3 per cent of personnel practicing allopathic medicine do not have a medical qualification.

The overriding requirement in the country is for increasing the supply of human resources at all levels from specialists to paramedical personnel and improve their quality. It is heartening to note that the Maharashtra Government has taken a very realistic and conscious decision in this direction. It has promulgated a Master plan of Medical education for the state, which conceived to open five M.B.B.S. Colleges in each district during the five year period starting from 2022 to 2027. Accordingly it is hoped that Medical education will get a great boost in Marathwada, which had only one Medical College at Aurangabad with 40 intake capacity, when I was an aspirant for the seat in 1959.

I pray for the development of human health care system on par with the developed countries for our people, since the human health care enjoys the paramount importance during any period of the civilization.

I am glad to be a witness in the huge task of erecting a gigantic Medical College building with all state-of-art facilities at Parbhani by Shri Dhaneshwari Manav Vikas Mandal. Students, parents and all those concerned may rest assured that their wards' future is in safe hands and Shri Dhaneshwari Manav Vikas Mandal will not leave any stone unturned to offer best quality education.

ABOUT PARBHANI MEDICAL COLLEGE

THE COLLEGE CAMPUS

Parbhani Medical College campus stretches over 25 acres of land. Out of that approximate 25 acres of land is developed with medical college, hospital and residential facility. The college building is a masterpiece of architecture which has state-of-the-art facilities and features all the amenities required during the course. The hospital building is an esthetically designed and appealing marvel. The college building contains beautifully constructed pre-clinical, para-clinical and clinical departments which makes learning a beautiful experience.

LECTURE HALLS

Parbhani Medical College has 2 well-furnished and spacious lecture halls with seating capacity of 220 students each. Lecture halls are equipped with latest audio visual aids like LCD projectors, computers, cordless microphones, slide projectors and facilities for E class room.

DEPARTMENTAL LIBRARY AND DEMONSTRATION ROOM

Every department has departmental library cum seminar rooms and Demonstration room with a seating capacity of 75 students along with audio visual aids like LCD projectors, computers, T.V., internet facility, etc.

AUDITORIUM

The college has a modern aesthetically designed, centrally air conditioned auditorium Hall. It is an architectural marvel that houses 400 students.

LIBRARY

As a dynamic and integral part of the academic and scholarly enterprise, the medical library of PMC is an essential component of the institute's intellectual mission, to educate and nurture the students, to create knowledge, and to provide service to the community and beyond. Spreaded over area of 1025 sq. mt, with a provision for reading rooms to accommodate more than 400 students, the library offers many national and international journals required for undergraduate students and faculty. Apart from online journals and E-library, each department has its own departmental library. The reading rooms are kept open from 9:00 am till midnight for the students to use according to convenience, need and habit.

The central library has been provided with Wi-Fi internet facility wherein students and faculty have open access to this facility. As the College and Hostels are 'Wi-Fi' enabled, the students can access information at any time in the campus.



CANTEEN

PMC provides various dining options for their students and faculty. Institutional Cafeteria provides snacks and beverages throughout the day. The cafeteria is well furnished and well maintained, open 365 days which serves a wide range of refreshment & fast food varieties with a homely touch for students.

EXPERT FACULTY AT PMC

Without any shadow of doubt, it is the members of the teaching community who impart knowledge to students. The greatest asset of PMC is highly qualified and experienced faculty with vast teaching experience in undergraduate and post graduate courses. The teaching faculty, is extremely dedicated and as per the requirements of National Medical Commission. The students are groomed to be excellent professionals with moral and ethical values. Our faculty are also invited as guest speakers from various well-known institutions and societies of the country. Senior members of the teaching staff are invited as paper setters, examiners and moderators by university from all over Maharashtra. The college encourages its faculty to attend workshops, seminars, conferences, symposia, etc.

MUSEUMS

There are departmental museums which cater a collection of mounted specimens, dry specimens, models, plates, charts for academic interest. There is a well maintained, orderly display of specimens with labeling and proper description in catalogue as well as in details in front of the specimens and models. The catalogue system in museum is maintained according to NMC criteria. They provide the students knowledge under the guidance of teachers for their subject of interest. Adequate seating arrangements are available in the museums where faculties and students can interact and read in detail for knowledge and research purpose.



DEPARTMENT OF ANATOMY

The Department of Anatomy is a full fledged department that has highly experienced and dedicated faculty along with the state of art infrastructure and facilities to impart high quality, clinically relevant education in an experiential learning environment. Our sole mission is to provide a comprehensive knowledge of the gross and microscopic structure and development of human body. We also aim to provide a basis for better understanding of the anatomical structures, various clinical problems and disease presentations.

(A) Demonstration Room - Two demonstration rooms fitted with strip chairs -Over Head Projector, Slide Projector, Television, Video and other audio-visual aids - Accommodation for at least 100 students.

(B) Dissection Hall - A well lit dissection hall with proper ventilation including exhaust fans and air-conditioners. There is an ante-room for students with lockers and wash basins. There are adequate teaching aids in the hall. In addition, there is an embalming room which has space for storage tanks and cold storage room with space for preserving dead bodies.

(C) Histology - Histology Laboratory with work benches fitted with water taps, sinks and cupboards for microscope storage and electric points for 100 students. There is a proper preparation room for technicians and storage of equipment.

(D) Research - There is a research laboratory which is used for research purposes.

(E) Museum - A museum with specimens, racks and shelves for storing and proper display of wet and dry specimens and embryological sections, models, revolving stands for skia grams, CT scans, MRI and trolley tables, X-ray view boxes. There is adequate seating accommodation for 100 students to study in the museum.

(F) Departmental Library - There is a departmental library-cum-seminar room with at least 205 books.



DEPARTMENT OF PHYSIOLOGY

We are envisioned to create dedicated, competent & compassionate doctors whose ultimate goal is to serve humanity & uphold the ideals of this noble profession. Physiology. The science of life is the foundation on which clinical medicine rests. Knowledge of the intricate workings of different body systems & their complex inter relationships forms the core of the subject. This understanding enables students to correlate between the pathology of a disease & its treatment, contributing to the development of the core skills of a competent doctor.

A. Demonstration Room:

There are two demonstration rooms fitted with strip chairs. The room also consists of overhead projector, slide projector, television, video and other audiovisual aids, so as to accommodate at least 100 students.

C. Departmental Library:

There is a departmental library-cum-seminar room with at least 200 books.

D. Research:

There is one research laboratory for research purposes.



DEPARTMENT OF BIOCHEMISTRY

The Department of Biochemistry is run by a group of experienced and talented doctors and faculty who provide diagnostic laboratory services to outpatients and inpatients. The laboratory is intended to serve as a referral laboratory for physicians of this hospital as well as for those practicing in the surrounding areas. Routine Biochemistry and specialized tests like hormones, Tumor markers vitamins etc., done in labs that have the latest equipments.

The faculty and students are encouraged to do research and publish scientific papers.

Demonstration room

Biochemistry department has two demonstration rooms, provided with Audio-Visual aids which can accommodate at least 100 students.

Departmental library

Biochemistry department has separate library with a capacity to easily accommodate 100 students.

Research laboratory

Research laboratory is equipped with UV-spectrometer, centrifuges, balances, hot air oven, electrophoresis apparatus, flame photometer etc. for research work in the department. The faculty members and undergraduate students are involved in research, pursuing core knowledge in the subject of Biochemistry and research.



HOSTELS

PMC has well furnished Boys and Girls hostel, residents hostel and nursing hostel, which comes closest to being a home away from home. Hostels have 24 hours power supply facility, hot water supply and round the clock security. Mess facilities are provided to the hostel-dwellers. Hostels features - common computerized reading room, gym facilities, common room with LED TV and indoor game facilities like chess, carrom, table tennis, etc. All hostels are fully Wi-Fi enabled with high speed internet connectivity.

The OPD is manned by senior general physician backed by the hospital's comprehensive diagnostic and therapeutic services. Patients in the lower income group receive free outpatient service. These include consultation, investigations and management.

General Medicine Department

Besides treating common medical conditions, the department maintains separate records of all serious and interesting problems, which form the basis of research. Well equipped Critical Care Units, including a bedside Dialyzer. Regular speciality clinics are conducted. Round the clock specialities are available for treating emergencies. Highly dedicated team is the strength of the department. The cardiac Stress Test Laboratory has state of the art equipment which helps in diagnosing, the efficacy of therapy in coronary heart disease. In addition, the patient's functional capacity can be measured and certain arrhythmias evaluated. PFT, EEG, EMG, Dialyzers, Imaging Studies, Digital Subtraction Angiography, add to the armamentarium.

Paediatrics Department

At the daily OPD, Pediatricians treat wide variety of childhood ailments. In addition, emergency care is provided round the clock with supportive services like PICU and NICU. Our hospital also conducts a "Well-Baby Clinic" that offers immunization, monitors growth and development of children and counsels mothers on nutrition and other child health related issues.



Speciality clinic are conducted every day to treat and follow up common Paediatric diseases like Asthma, Seizure disorder, various heart diseases, nephrology case and newborn special high risk baby clinic are also conducted every week.

GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT COURSE

M.B. B.S. DEGREE course under the Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik. Duration 4 and ½ years + 1 year compulsory residential rotatory internship. Eligibility marks - As per NMC / NTA / Government of Maharashtra / MUHS norms.

ADMISSION :

All the admission in M.B.B.S. course for the Academic year 2023-24 at this institution in all quota (Merit Quota and NRI quota) will be done by the Competent Authority/Commissioner, State CET Cell, Mumbai through “Centralized Admission Procedure” or as per the directions issued by the Competent Authority from time to time. The guidelines for admission for the academic year 2023-2024 is available on website of State CET Cell, www.mahacet.org. and issued from time to time.

Age Limit: Candidates should have completed 17 years of age as on 31st December of the year of admission. Date of birth given in the HSC/CBSE/ISC mark sheet or in the Birth Certificate shall be taken for computing age of the candidate.

SYLLABUS As per National Medical Commission / Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik.

(A) TIME DISTRIBUTION :- The first two semesters shall be occupied in the phase I (pre-clinical) subjects and introduction to a broader understanding of the perspectives of medical education leading to delivery of health care.

(B) ATTENDANCE :-

90% of attendance in theory and 90 % attendance in practical classes is compulsory. (or prescribed by the MUHS, Nashik from time to time)

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF PARBHANI MEDICAL COLLEGE

A. GENERAL RULES :

- 1) The College believes that duty, decorum and discipline are the hallmarks of a good student. Students with such qualities alone can prove to be productive manpower with an appreciable value system. Therefore erring students would be subjected to certain disciplinary code.
- 2) Under disciplinary action, the Dean is empowered to fine, suspend or even expel a student from Parbhani Medical College in the interests of the institution
- 3) Students are not permitted to use Mobile Phones inside classrooms, practical halls, academic and hospital area
- 4) BROWSING IS NOT ALLOWED DURING LAB HOURS. Staff and students are not allowed to misuse the internet facilities.
- 5) No one will be allowed to listen to music from any device inside the academic and hospital area.
- 6) Every student shall conduct himself / herself in such a way that they cause no disturbance to the working of the classes or fellow students.
- 7) RAGGING, CONSUMING ALCOHOL AND SMOKING ARE STRICTLY PROHIBITED IN THE PARBHANI MEDICAL COLLEGE CAMPUS.
- 8) No function shall be arranged by the students in the Parbhani Medical College campus without prior permission from the Dean
- 9) Writing on walls, pillars, bath rooms, furniture or boards is strictly prohibited.
- 10) Eating snacks / taking lunch inside the class rooms or along corridors are not permitted.
- 11) The cost of any damage, if caused to Parbhani Medical College property will be charged to the accounts of the students, responsible for the damage in addition to disciplinary action.
- 12) Students are advised to switch off fans and lights when they leave the class rooms.
- 13) Furniture in the class rooms should not be moved or displaced.
- 14) No one will be allowed to whistle, hoot, shout or sing while moving in the corridor. They are also not allowed to throw papers or other articles anywhere than specified area.
- 15) In the event of continued poor performance in internal tests and poor class attendance by any student, the Dean has the authority to withhold permission for him/her to appear in the university examination as per the rules of MUHS, Nashik.
- 16) Parbhani Medical College working hours are: 9.00 am to 1.00 pm, 2.00 pm to 5 pm. (subject to change from time to time)
- 17) Internal assessment is part of the evaluation. Please check the marks displayed on the notice board and bring any discrepancy to the notice of the Dean or HOD immediately. Change is not possible later.
- 18) Except under special conditions, late comers are not allowed to enter in class without a note from the Dean. Without the lecturer's permission students are not permitted to leave the class.
- 19) When a leave is availed for unforeseen reasons, the leave application must be forwarded to the Dean through the concerned Heads of all the Departments.
- 20) Participation in co-curricular or extra-curricular activities inside or outside the campus is not counted as absence from class. Attendance will be counted only when a copy of the participation certificate or a note from the concerned teacher is produced immediately before the Dean or an Officer authorized by him, subject to the rules of MUHS, Nashik
